More recently, GRSA members have been performing in quartets with fun names like Java Jive, Sticky Notes, Chime In, All In A-Chord, Joyride, Zenith, Sublime & Painted Lips, just to name a few. Many talented quartets have come together to perform over the 70+ year history of GRSA. In fact, if you take a detailed look, you will find that many of our members were part of more than one quartet, often switching from one part to another to complete a foursome.

One quartet that has recently made it's mark is Clefhanger. Featuring current GRSA associate member Jessica VanBeek (Lead), Jeff Opperman (Bass), former GRSA member Jen Nolte (Tenor) and her husband Paul Nolte (Bari); Clefhanger is a mixed quartet. After taking 2 years off during the Covid epidemic, Clefhanger joined the Barbershop Harmony Society and competed for the first time at their spring convention this past April, here in Grand Rapids at the DeVos Center for Arts and Worship. They placed 9th in their division which entitled them to be the official "mic testers" at the Saturday night finals.

In August, Clefhanger traveled to Cadillac to compete in the 76th Bush League Barbershop Contest where they were awarded FIRST PLACE in the mixed quartet division! This award winning quartet most recently sang at the Great Lakes Chorus Caberet on Sept. 30th at the Forest Hills Presbyterian Church with many of our GRSA sisters in the audience.
